1	Royal Marines Cadets Arduous Course	<p>Location: Commando Training Centre Royal Marines (CTCRM)</p> <p>Aim: The course follows the basic out-line of the Potential Royal Marines Course (PRMC), and the instruction is conducted by Royal Marines Staff from the Corps Colonels Department and will enable you to see the physical and mental standards that are required to successfully pass the PRMC if you are interested in joining the Royal Marines.</p> <p>Qualification: Successful completion of the week counts towards your BTEC in Public Services. All candidates must hold a current WHT on the L98A2. (CFAVs & Cadet Weapons Training History Logs must be submitted on arrive)</p> <p>Eligibility: Minimum age 16 yrs. This course is open to Royal Marines Cadets and Blue Jackets of equivalent Rank and Age who have an interest in joining the Royal Marines.</p> <p>Course Content: 3 Mile Run and RMFT, Recce/OP's/Patrolling, Harbour Drills and Routines, Troop Weapons Acquaint, Endurance Course, Fitness Competition, Bottom Field Assault Course, PLT's and Tyrol Traverse, Map Reading and Fieldcraft.
