1	Royal Marines Cadets CFAVs Military Train the Trainer Course	<p>Aim: This Course is designed so that CFAV can gain a number of trainer's qualifications during one week.</p> <p>Eligibility: Company Commanders and Company Training Officers are to identify experienced RMC CFAVs within their Companies to attend the course. All candidates are to be endorsed by the Company Commander in writing to the SRMO/RMCTO.</p> <p>The criteria for eligibility to attend is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Experienced CFAVs of a substantive Rank b. Hold a current valid First Aid qualification as recognised by JSP535 (April 2011). c. Hold an IM Grade 2. d. Must be current, competent and qualified on the L98A2 Weapon System (Weapon Handling Test). e. 2	Royal Marines Cadets Drill Leaders Course	<p>Aim: The course will include all interval, squad and arms Drill instruction.</p> <p>Qualification: RMC Drill Leader. A qualifying course for RMC WO1/WO2, CSgt's and confirmed Sgt's for Drill Leader.</p> <p>Eligibility: This course is ONLY open to Royal Marines Cadets CFAVs WO1/WO2 and SNCOs. Company Drill weekends must be undertaken before application is made. Applications must be endorsed by the Company Drill Leader and Company Commander.</p> <p>Course Places: 1 x Instructor 12 x RMC CFAVs</p> <p>Dates: Sunday 5 Aug to Friday 10 Aug 2012</p>	Apply on Westminster

3	King George VI Memorial Leadership Course (KGVl)	<p>Aim: To study practical leadership and the planning and conduct of safe training involving blank ammunition and pyrotechnics at detachment and contingent level.</p> <p>Qualification: Successful completion of the course qualifies officers and adult instructors as an Exercise Conducting Officer (ECO) and awards the SA (M) (07) (Cadet) qualification.</p> <p>Eligibility: Candidates are to be RMC CFAVs.</p> <p>Arrival Documentation: Candidates must arrive with an in date Weapon Handling Test (WHT) certificates on the Cadet GP L98A2.</p> <p>Closing Date for Applications: Closing dates on WESTMINSTER will be strictly adhered to (this is at least 8 weeks prior to the start of every course). Nominations for allocated places on KGVl courses will be actioned within one week of receipt wherever possible.
