Key message:

The RM Cadet community is spread across 3 organisations, totalling over 3000 RM Cadets and instructors. Historically these organisations have operated separately with each RM Cadet organisation displaying different badges and identification insignia. In order to bring conformity and unity of identity across the RM Cadet community it has been decided to standardise badges and insignia.

All RMC CFAVs and Cadets will be issued one set of the new badges free of charge per person. Company Commanders, Company Staff, Troop Officers and COs/Det Cdrs may now order badges, orders will be issued against existing RMC complement, as given on Westminster. Badges are to be ordered through SCC Stores. Please only order the badges you require for your CFAVs and Cadets, e.g. if you don't have stone shirts, don't order the Bronze RMC Shoulder Title and SCC Badge (White on Stone).










Distribution will commence on a 1st come first served basis, with effect from 1 January 2012.

<p>Block letters, Size 13mm, Anodised. Worn in the centre of the shoulder straps below badges of rank and 13mm above the shoulder seam. Worn on the following Dress No.1A, 1B, 1C, 2C, 3A. Not worn by Colonels. Anodised</p>	 Anodised for No.1A & 2C	 Bronze for No. 1B & 1C	 Bronze for 3A	
<p>Badge SCC (Circular). To be worn on all orders of dress, including CS95 on the left arm, 51mm below the shoulder seam. The colours vary according to the order of dress.</p>	 Gold on Blue for No.1A	 Gold on Lovat for No.2C	 White on Stone for 3A	 Black on Green for CS95 and Jumper Heavy Wool
<p>Royal Marines Cadet Flashes. All CFAVs and Cadets that wear the jersey wool heavy are to wear a red on black "Royal Marines Cadet" flash on both sleeves. The badge is to be sewn centrally with its upper edge touching the shoulder seams.</p>	 Red on Blue for Jumper Heavy Wool			
<p>A black on green "Royal Marines Cadet" flash is to be worn by all RM Cadet establishments that wear CS95. The flash is to be attached centrally with its upper edge 7mm below the shoulder seams.</p>	 Black on Green for CS95 (Shirts and Jackets)
